



Draft Dangerous, Affected and Insanitary Buildings Policy 2023

Southland District Council is reviewing its Dangerous, Affected and Insanitary Buildings Policy and is inviting submissions on the draft policy.

This policy allows Council to identify and manage dangerous, affected and insanitary buildings in the District so that people who use buildings can do so safely and without endangering their health. The draft policy sets out Council's responsibilities under the Building Act 2004 and ensures that when dangerous or affected buildings are identified, the danger is appropriately reduced. Similarly, if insanitary conditions are found, that appropriate and timely measures are undertaken to remedy this. The draft policy also states Council's approach to heritage buildings that are identified as dangerous or insanitary.
