Southland District Council is reviewing its Smoke-Free Open Spaces Policy and is inviting submissions on the draft policy.

This policy encourages no smoking or vaping in Council's open spaces through signage and promotion, particularly at locations where young people gather. Please note that this policy is not enforceable but serves as an educational tool.
