Draft alcohol control bylaw

Southland District Council is now inviting submissions on the draft Alcohol Control Bylaw 2022.

This form is for the purpose of sharing your views with, and making a submission to, Council on the draft Alcohol Control Bylaw 2022.

Council is proposing a new bylaw that will continue the effect of the current Alcohol Control Bylaw 2015, which is scheduled to expire on 9 December 2022.

The bylaw prohibits the possession and consumption of alcohol in specific public places within the Southland district, which is currently limited to central Te Anau. It also allows Council to establish further temporary alcohol bans in other areas when required.

The public consultation period runs from 8am on Monday 29 August 2022, to 5pm on Thursday 29 September 2022.

We would appreciate any feedback you have on this draft bylaw.


